Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship committee. Minimum award is \$1,500. Scholarship winners will be notified in late May via postal mail. Winners will also be posted on the GFWC Illinois website: gfwcillinois.org

If selected to receive a scholarship, the student will be required to show a letter of acceptance from the school the student will attend in the Fall of 2023. Checks are mailed and written directly to the university, college, or trade school.
